For the 19th consecutive year, the Mule Deer Foundation (MDF) is selling tickets and conducting a raffle for the New Mexico Lt. Governor's Deer Enhancement License.

Proceeds from the raffle will be used for deer management and conservation in New Mexico. The license will be authorized for use from September 1 2022 through January 31 2023 with any legal sporting arm. The license will be valid statewide only on public land where hunting is allowed, including Department owned WMAs and private land with prior written permission. The bag limit for this hunt is one buck deer.
